We will always store your personal details securely. We'll use them to provide you with the service that you have requested and communicate with you in the way(s) that you have agreed to.

Your data may also be used for analysis purposes, to help us to provide the best service possible. We will only allow your information to be used by suppliers working on our behalf and we'll only share it if required to do so by law.

The Website

We take a proactive approach to user privacy and ensure the necessary steps are taken to protect the privacy of our website users throughout their visiting experience. This website complies with all UK legislation and requirements for user privacy. The policy will be reviewed and updated in line with any subsequent legislation.

Use of Cookies

The website uses cookies to improve the user's experience. Where applicable this website uses a cookie control system allowing the user on their first visit to the website to allow or disallow the use of cookies on their computer / device.

Cookies are small files saved to the user's computer's hard drive that track, save and store information about the user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server to provide the user's with a tailored experience within the website.

Email Newsletter

process is detailed at the footer of each email campaign. If an automated un-subscription system is unavailable, clear instructions on how to un-subscribe will be detailed instead.
